"Always Wear Your Seat Belt"

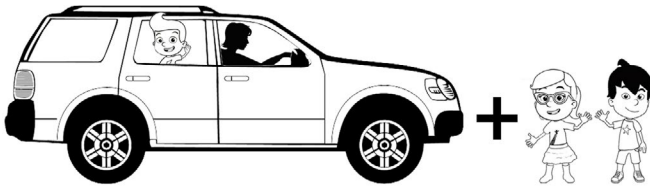

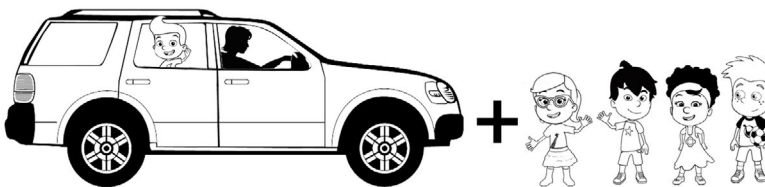
