MAKE YOUR OWN BUMPER STICKER

1.L.2: Demonstrate command of the conventions of standard English capitalization, punctuation, and spelling when writing.

Have students make their own, custom bumper stickers about respect that they can display and share with everyone!

Materials Needed:

- Sticky paper
- "Respect" template
- Crayons, markers, or colored pencils
- Scissors
- Printer

Preparation:

- Gather the needed materials in an appropriate area.
- Print out the "Respect" template on sheets of sticky paper and cut them out to be the designated bumper sticker size.

Steps to Success:

1. Pass out a "Respect" bumper sticker to each student.
2. Write some or all of the following phrases on the whiteboard for the students to see:
 - Treat others the way you want to be treated.
 - Respect means showing others that you care.
 - There is no such thing as a small act of kindness.
 - Treat everyone like they are the most important person you'll meet today.
 - Respect everyone and respect yourself.
3. Go over these phrases with the students. Ask students what they think the phrases mean.
4. Have students pick one of these phrases to write in the blank space on the bumper sticker. They can also make up their own phrase about respect if they want.
5. Allow students to decorate their bumper stickers with crayons, markers, or colored pencils.
