## "Help in the Kitchen"

### PREPARE FOR PREPOSITIONS!

A **preposition** sits before a noun or pronoun to show the noun's relationship to another word in the sentence. Think about anywhere a plane can go in the clouds!

**Examples:** *The plane flew **through** the cloud.*

*The plane went **over** the cloud.*

*The plane flew **under** the cloud.*

*The plane went **to** the cloud.*
