



## ALWAYS BE A GOOD SPORT SOCCER BALL!

**1.L.2:** Demonstrate command of the conventions of standard English capitalization, punctuation, and spelling when writing.

Winning can be fun, but the most important thing is trying your best. Win or lose, you should always be a good sport and be nice to the other team. Students will cut out a soccer ball and give it to someone they've played with who displayed good sportsmanship.

### Materials Needed:

- "Soccer Ball" template
- Markers, crayons
- Scissors

### Preparation:

- Gather the needed materials in the appropriate area.
- Print out the "Soccer Ball" template on sheets of paper for the students.

### Steps to Success:

1. Pass out a "Soccer Ball" template to each student.
2. Write some or all of the following phrases on the whiteboard for the students to see:
  - Treat others the way you want to be treated.
  - Being a good sport means telling others that they did a good job.
  - Always play by the rules.
  - Be kind to your teammates.
  - Listen to what your teacher or coach says.
  - Respect everyone and respect yourself.
  - Always tell friends on the other team that they did a good job, too.
3. Have the students copy one of the phrases onto their soccer ball before giving it to a friend.
