K.L.2: Demonstrate command of the conventions of standard English capitalization, punctuation, and spelling when writing.

Materials Needed:

- "Soccer Ball" template
- Markers, crayons
- Scissors

Preparation:

- Gather the needed materials in the appropriate area.
- Print out the "Soccer Ball" template on sheets of paper for the students.

Steps to Success:

1. Pass out a "Soccer Ball" template to each student.
2. Write some or all of the following phrases on the whiteboard for the students to see:
 - Be kind to others.
 - Use kind words.
 - Play by the rules.
 - Be nice to your teammates.
 - Listen to what your teacher or coach says.
3. Have the students copy one of the phrases onto their soccer ball before giving it to a friend.
