

GET YOURSELF READY FOR SOCCER

CC.K-12.MP.6: Attend to precision.

K.G.4: Analyze and compare two- and three-dimensional shapes, in different sizes and orientations, using informal language to describe their similarities, differences, parts (e.g., number of sides and vertices/"corners") and other attributes (e.g., having sides of equal length).

Do your students know what they need to wear and how to get themselves ready for soccer? Have them cut out the necessary items to wear on the soccer field and attach them to the craft stick. Have them use this as a reminder of what you must wear to get ready for soccer!

Materials Needed:

- Enough copies of the cut-out soccer items for each student
- Craft sticks for each student
- Glue sticks
- Markers or crayons
- Scissors

Steps to Success:

1. Have your students color and cut out the items on the soccer worksheet.
2. Have them glue the soccer pictures in the correct order on the craft stick.
3. Once they have dried, instruct your students to decorate their projects.
4. Tell your students to use this project as a reminder of what to bring to a soccer game.

Preparation:

- Gather the needed materials in an appropriate area.
- Provide each student with a craft stick and a soccer worksheet.
- Provide scissors and glue sticks for each desk.
- Provide markers or crayons for each group of students to decorate their projects.
