



LINE UP PEOPLE CHAIN

K.CC.4a: When counting objects, say the number names in the standard order, pairing each object with one and only one number name and each number name with one and only one object.

K.CC.4c: Understand that each successive number name refers to a quantity that is one larger.

Create a Friendship Line by cutting out the figures and putting them in order from 1-10. For even more fun, have the students join their chains together with other students' and use them to decorate the room!

Materials Needed:

- Crayons or markers
- Tape or glue
- Scissors
- Stickers, yarn and any other misc. materials to decorate the projects with

Preparation:

- Photocopy and distribute the template on the following page to your students.

Steps to Success:

1. Have your students color and decorate the figures any way they'd like and then carefully cut out the figures.
2. Have your students put them in numerical order from 1-10.
3. Using the tape or glue, have the students attach them hand to hand with other students' chains...see how long you can make your classroom chain!
